



A Reading from the Book of Exodus (24:12-18)

Exodus 24:12-18

The LORD said to Moses, "Come up to me on the mountain, and wait there; and I will give you the tablets of stone, with the law and the commandment, which I have written for their instruction." So Moses set out with his assistant Joshua, and Moses went up into the mountain of God. Exodus 24:12-18-1/3

To the elders he had said, "Wait here for us, until we come to you again; for **Aaron and Hur are with you; whoever** has a dispute may go to them." Then Moses went up on the mountain, and the cloud covered the mountain. The glory of the LORD settled on Mount Sinai, and the cloud covered it for six days; Exodus 24:12-18-2/3

on the seventh day he called to Moses out of the cloud. Now the appearance of the glory of the LORD was like a devouring fire on the top of the mountain in the sight of the people of Israel. Moses entered the cloud, and went up on the mountain. Moses was on the mountain for forty days and forty nights. Exodus 24:12-18-3/3 end


After receiving your wafer, please step to the side and remove your mask before consuming the bread and wine.


