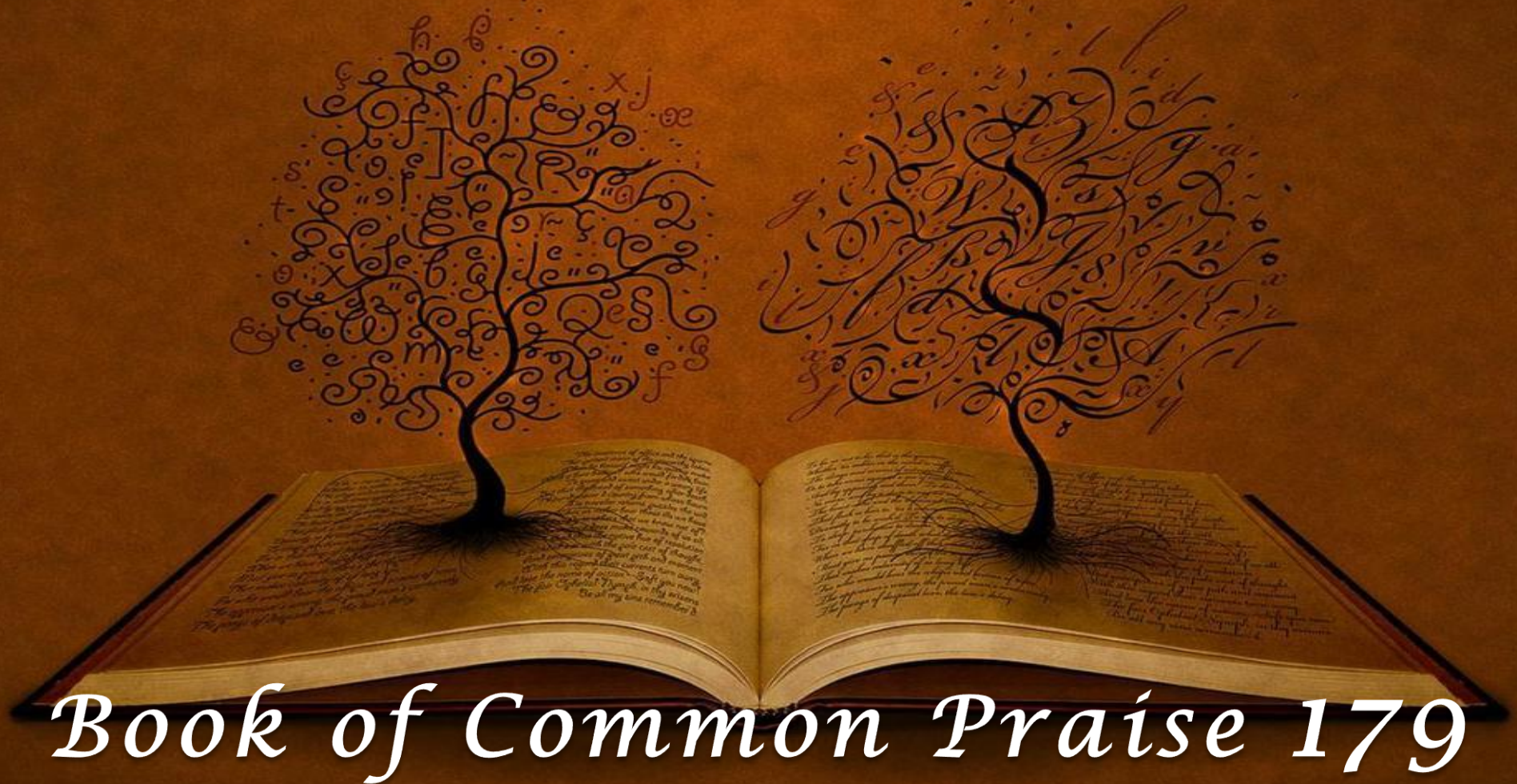

Philippians 3:17-4:1

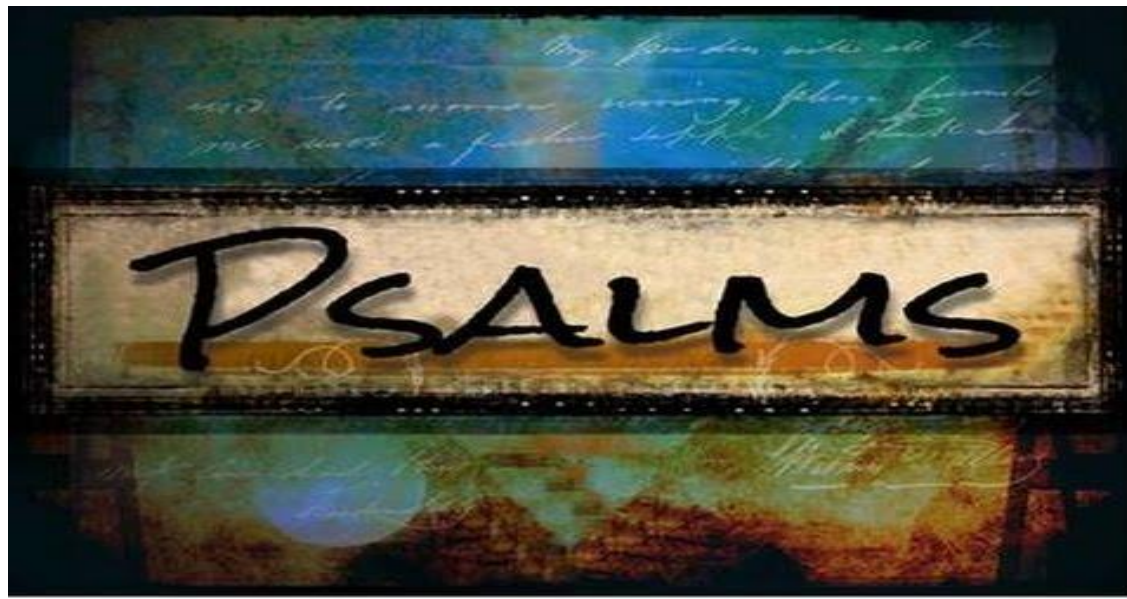

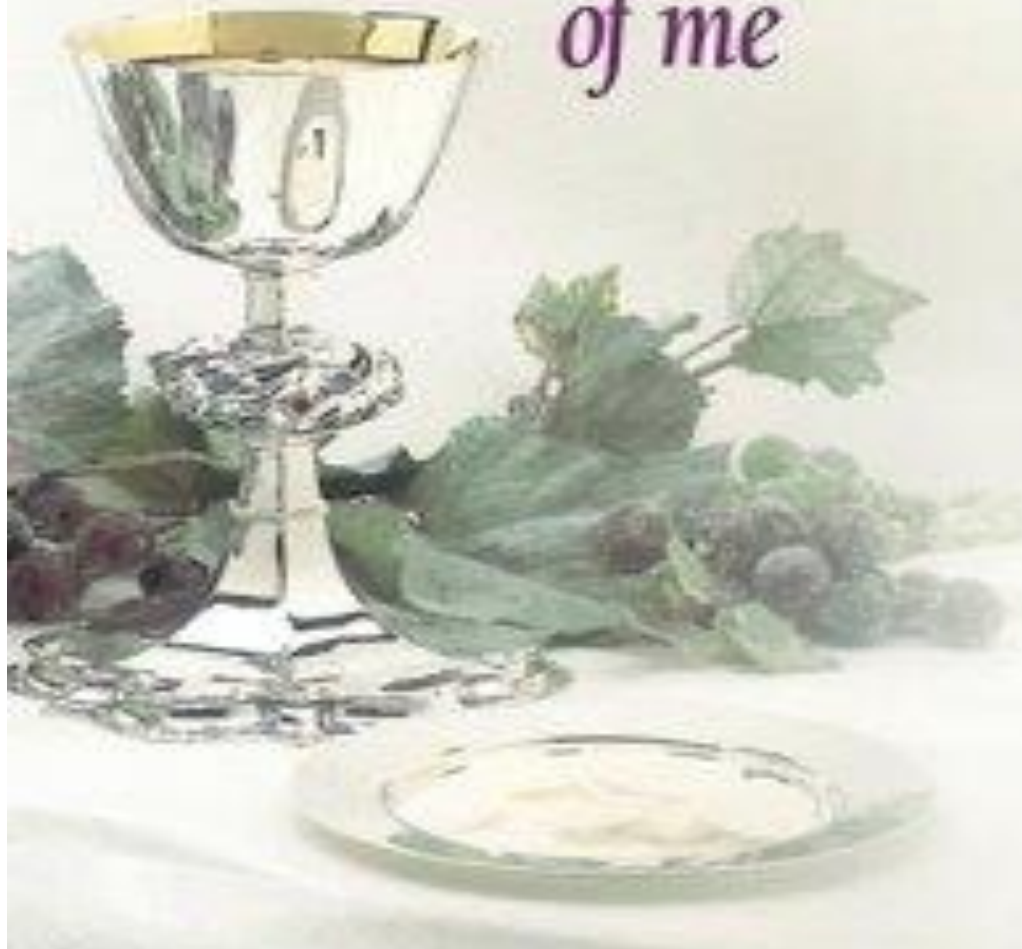

Christ is risen.

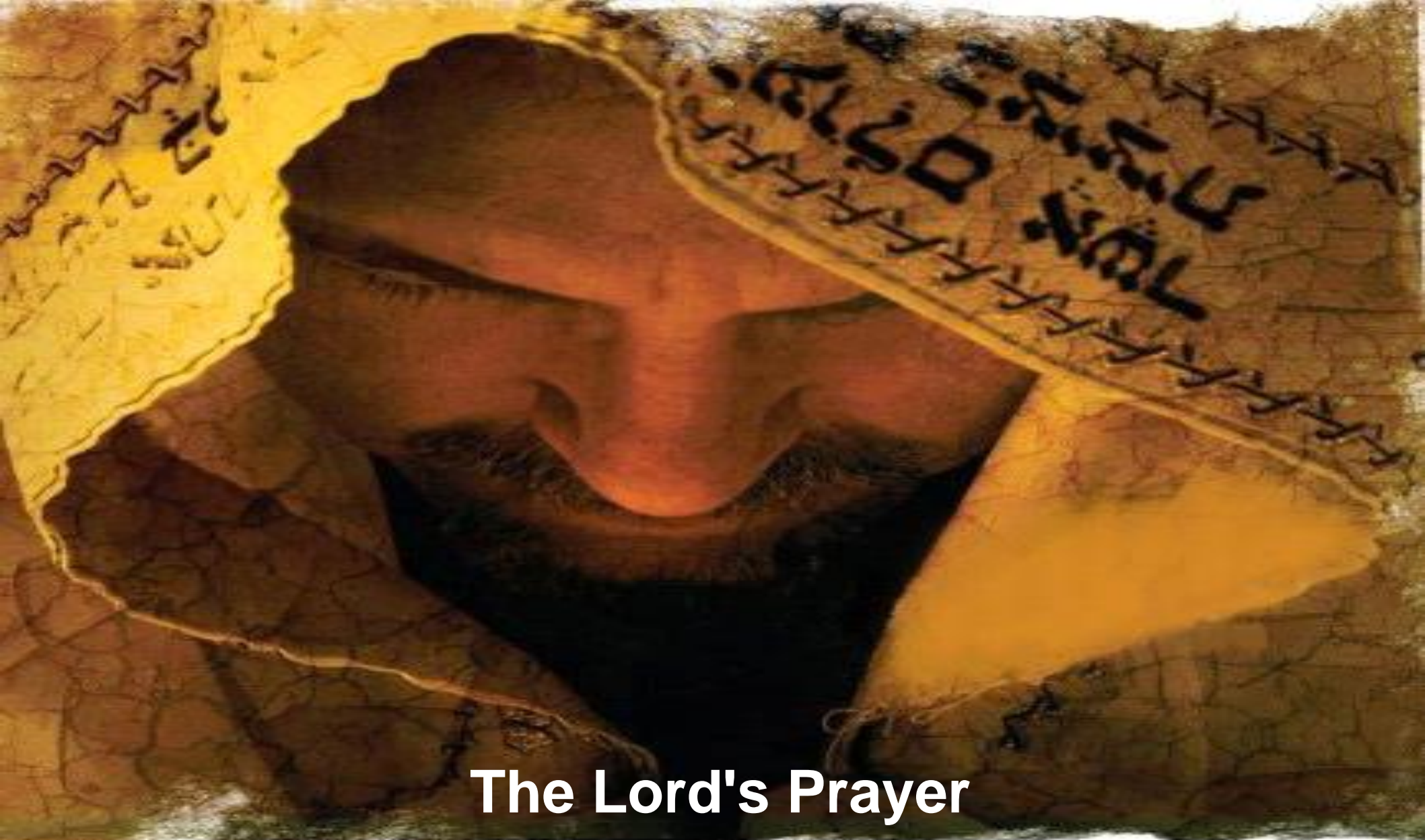
Christ will come again.
